The staff is dedicated to engaging, communicating, and connecting with our members on a daily basis. They help coordinate our 12 member-led neighborhood circles spread throughout the city. They help provide support and space for the LGBTQ circles, the artists circle, the over-90 group, fitness exercise, meditation, and creative writing – just to mention a sampling of what we offer at San Francisco Village. We are grateful for the active involvement of our members and volunteers who make this a vital, creative and engaged community.

A Community of Belonging

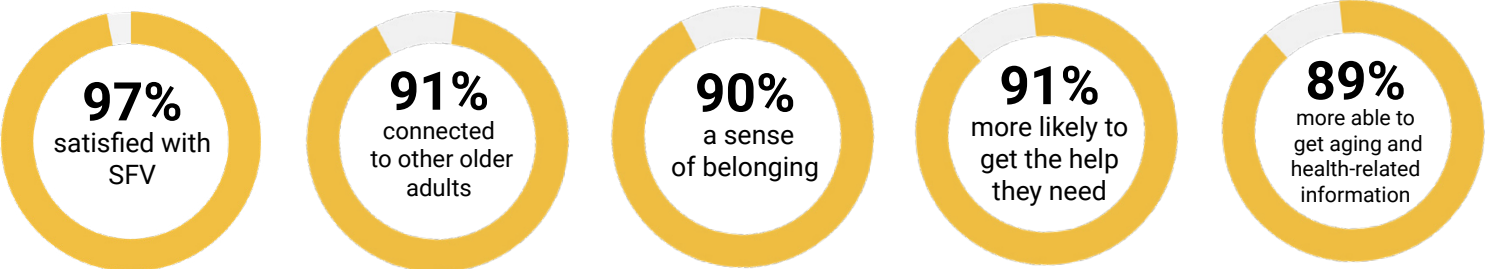
Member-led events (book clubs, Saturday night social, Grupo de Conversación en Español, games, and more) and neighborhood circles accounted for **42% of all programming** in 2025, proving that San Francisco Village is successfully operating as a member-powered network.

The Artists Circle emerged as a strong pillar of the Village’s creative community. In 2025 alone, circle members hosted over **24 dedicated sessions**, with a remarkably high participation rate. These gatherings contribute to the broader Arts & Culture category, which saw a total of 1,254 attendances over the last two years, making it one of the most consistent drivers of social connection.

By fostering a space where members share techniques and showcase their work, the Artists Circle is an example of how San Francisco Village leverages member expertise to create meaningful social connection that keeps our community vibrant and inspired.

Confident Living Independently

San Francisco Village serves as a fundamental lifeline for our members, particularly for the **70% of our members who live alone and the women who make up two-thirds of our membership**. By providing a trusted bridge to over **800 vetted resources in 2025**, we provided our members with the agency to navigate the complexities of aging on their own terms. Since joining, **86% of members feel more confident about aging in their own home and 91% are more likely to reach out for the support they need**. Whether seeking emotional connection, navigating health transitions, or securing practical help with home repairs and technology, our members no longer face these challenges in isolation. Instead, they move forward with the information and community backing necessary to thrive in the homes they love.

The Value of Being Well Connected

When Arabella returned home after a painful fall, San Francisco Village quickly stepped in to bridge the gap between medical care and daily life. Our team coordinated a dedicated network of volunteers to assist with essential chores, groceries, and companionship during her months-long recovery. Arabella later shared that this steadfast support was more than just a service—it was the key to her successful healing, providing the peace of mind that comes from a community truly looking out for her well-being.

Grief Program

The Grief Program in partnership with San Francisco Village offers a compassionate, peer-led environment where no one has to walk their path alone. In 2025, we supported **141 griever**s through our weekly sessions and welcomed 28 participants into our intensive 8-week Traumatic Loss Grief Group. Spanning a **diverse age range from 26 to 95**, this intergenerational program fosters healing. Through a donation-based model offering accessible online meetings, we ensure that support is available to everyone, regardless of their circumstances.

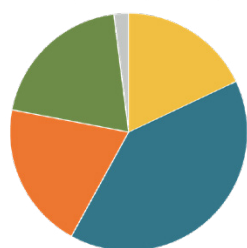

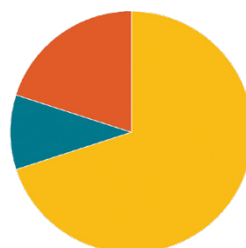
2025 Financials
